RENEWAL APPLICATION

The Annette M. Brown Scholarship Fund provides support to residents of Androscoggin County pursuing a post-secondary degree at a two- or four-year college. Eligible applicants must demonstrate a level of academic achievement suitable for predicting success in college, strong character and family values, and a Federal Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$5,000 or less. Preference will be given to applicants who will be in the first generation of their family to attend college in the United States. There is a strong preference for students attending accredited colleges in, first, Androscoggin County and, second, Maine. Students attending schools outside of Maine will be given lowest priority.

Recipients are invited to apply for renewal consideration. Preference will be given to students in their second, third and fourth year of post-secondary school who might not have access to high school scholarship awards available to first year students. The number of awards will be determined by the funds available for distribution each year and the number of qualified applicants.

All applications and required information sent separately must be postmarked by June 1. Incomplete applications or those postmarked after this date will not be processed.
