

# Pearl Starbird Scholarship Fund

## Guidelines

### ***History:***

Pearl Starbird is an accomplished artist and musician. She shared her passion for art for many years as a teacher in the Boston schools. Her skill as a cellist was a more personal interest, which she enjoyed with her friends. Although she worked in Boston throughout her career, Pearl considered her family's camp in Waterford to be her home. This is where she spent her summer vacations and came to live when she retired from teaching. She brought her love of classical music and art to Waterford and established this scholarship to encourage students who share her passion to pursue their education in these fields.

### ***Purpose:***

The purpose of this fund is to provide renewable scholarship support to graduates of any Oxford County, Maine, high school or Lake Region High School in Naples, Maine, to pursue college-level education in music or the arts. This fund is meant to make the difference between a student choosing to major in art or music as opposed to a "more practical" course of study.

### ***Eligibility:***

Graduates of high schools in Oxford County and Lake Region High School who are majoring in music or the arts at the college level are eligible to apply.

Preference is given to students who plan to study classical music. Students of other genres of music must demonstrate a component of studio training/discipline in their curriculum.

Preference is also given to students planning to study the fine arts, with special consideration given to painting, drawing, and sculpture.

Eligible applicants will be students in good academic standing with a demonstrated interest in the arts or music. Recipients must apply for renewal consideration annually. Financial need may be taken into consideration in the case of similar applicants.

Art and music, in this case, are not to be confused with architecture, interior design/decorating, landscape design/architecture and culinary arts, all of which are equally exciting endeavors, but which are not the focus of this scholarship.

### ***Awards:***

Annual awards will be based on the recommendation of the selection committee and be dependent on available funds. Preference will be given to the recipients of prior grants from the Starbird Fund who are enrolled in and attempting to complete an undergraduate degree. Award monies used for expenses other than tuition, books and supplies must be reported as taxable income by the recipient. It is the responsibility of the recipient to report and pay any tax liability.

- Resume, including performance/exhibit history, awards, honors, community service, employment and internships.
- A letter of recommendation from a current art or music teacher detailing your accomplishments and your commitment to a career in your chosen field. The letter must be current (dated after January 1, 2012), on official letterhead, contain your first and last name, and be signed by the writer, who must identify his/her relationship to you (not a family member). E-mail letters are not acceptable.
- A copy of your college financial aid offer (returning students may submit prior year letter).

It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit all of the required items on or before the application deadline. Incomplete applications or those postmarked after April 15 will not be processed. All information received from applicants will be held in confidence.

Please be sure to orient your images correctly. Accurate and simple representations of your artwork are paramount. You may include both full views and details of works. Full views of works should precede detail shots. Please include a list with the title/description, medium, and size of each piece of artwork in the portfolio.
