Phillips Family Scholarship Guidelines

History and Purpose – to provide scholarship support to residents of Shirley, Maine who have successfully completed 2 semesters of post-secondary study. Renewals may be made at the discretion of the scholarship committee.

Eligibility - Eligible applicants are residents of Shirley, Maine

Awards - This is a renewable scholarship. Recipients must apply each year for renewed support. The number and size of awards is dependent upon the budget and the number of eligible applicants each year.

Administration – This award will be paid in December, for the spring semester of study. The scholarship will be made directly to the recipient's school, for the benefit of the student.

All applications must be postmarked no later than May 15
